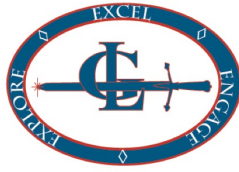

Mr. Greg Serian spoke to the Berkeley Heights School District's community on May 6th, 2021 as part of our Genocide Awareness Month commemoration. As a teacher, I believe that it is most important to learn about all historical events from those who endured them. Mr. Serian's presentation provided a comprehensive overview of the Armenian Genocide while seamlessly integrating his grandmother's story of her experiences.
